

Green Anole

Native to: Southeast U.S.A.

Size: 9-12 inches

Lifespan: 3-6 years

Enclosure: no less than a 20 gallon for a pair

Temps: 75-90 gradient, 65-70 at night

Lighting: UVB

Diet: Crickets, mealworms, cockroaches, dusted

Humidity: 60-70%

Furniture: Climbing vines and branches. Keep in mind that if you take sticks and rocks from the wild, they must be boiled for 5 minutes or baked in the oven at 350 degrees for 30 minutes. Make sure you know if any of the materials are toxic to your pet (i.e. cedar), and be certain it is not illegal to collect it from the wild!

* Due to quickness of these lizards they are considered a “hands off” species. They are fairly hardy in captivity and are fun to watch*
