

Mountain Horned Dragon

Native to: Burma, Thailand, Malaysia, Indonesia, Cambodia, Vietnam and Southern China

Size: 10-14 inches

Enclosure: 4 ft high by 3 ft long

Light: UVB

Food: Crickets, mealworms and other feeder insects, dusted

Furniture: Climbing vines, sticks, running water. Keep in mind that if you take sticks and rocks from the wild, they must be boiled for 5 minutes or baked in the oven at 350 degrees for 30 minutes. Make sure you know if any of the materials are toxic to your pet (i.e. cedar), and be certain it is not illegal to collect it from the wild!
