

## **Red Eyed Tree Frog**

**Native to:** S. Mexico to Eastern Panama

**Size:** 2-3 inches

**Enclosure:** 5 gallons per frog, tall enclosure, lids of cage ½ glass and ½ screen

**Temps:** Day 75-80 degrees, 70-75 at night

**Light:** 12 hour photoperiod

**Substrate:** 3-5 inches soil like substrate and sphagnum moss, aquarium gravel for drainage

**Humidity:** 60-70%

**Diet:** Crickets, Fruit Flies

**Furniture:** Dish to soak in. Keep in mind that if you take sticks and rocks from the wild, they must be boiled for 5 minutes or baked in the oven at 350 degrees for 30 minutes. Make sure you know if any of the materials are toxic to your pet (i.e. cedar), and be certain it is not illegal to collect it from the wild!

**Maintenance:** Mist when needed to maintain humidity
