Native to: California, Arizona, and Mexico

Size: 24-42"

Lifespan: 18 years

Enclosure: 20 gallon

Temperature: Thermal Gradient, daytime 82 degrees, basking spot 85-90, nighttime 68

Diet: Rodents Feed food items that are no thicker than the thickest part of the snake's body. I prefer to feed all my snakes frozen / thawed. Maintenance: Fresh water and spot cleaning, low humidity

Cage Furniture: Hide box, limbs/shelves for climbing. Keep in mind that if you take sticks and rocks from the wild, they must be boiled for 5 minutes or baked in the oven at 350 degrees for 30 minutes. Make sure you know if any of the materials are toxic to your pet (i.e. cedar), and be certain it is not illegal to collect it from the wild!
