

Sand Boa

Native to: East Africa

Size: up to 40”

Lifespan: 15 years

Enclosure: 20 gallon

Temperature: Thermal Gradient, Daytime 85 degrees, basking spot 95, nighttime 75

Diet: Rodents

Feeding: Once a week, will go “off-feed”. Feed food items that are no thicker than the thickest part of the snake’s body. I prefer to feed all my snakes frozen / thawed. Maintenance: Fresh water and spot cleaning, humidity box should be provided

Substrate: 3-5” deep of aspen or sand/soil mix. These snakes love to bury themselves into the substrate and will spend a great deal of time hidden from site.
